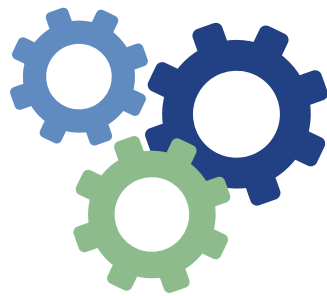

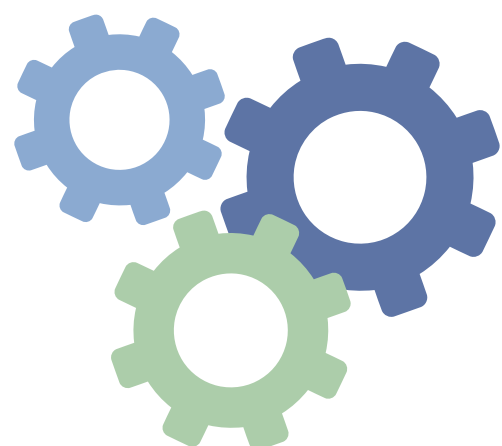
What Are We Aiming For?

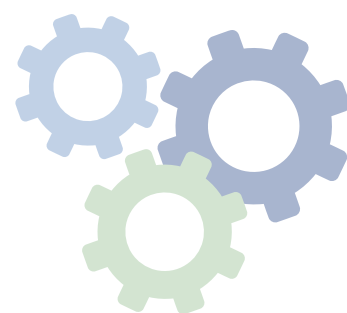


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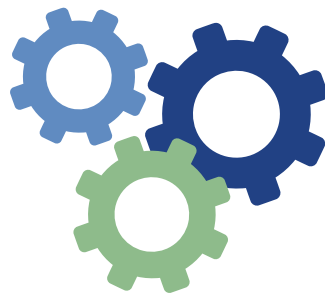
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What's New in the Project

The FARMS 5.0 project is currently advancing its work on analysing the state of Agriculture 5.0 across Europe. Partners have been carrying out research and collecting feedback from different stakeholder groups to better understand how modern technologies and innovative approaches are shaping the future of agriculture. The ongoing research explores topics such as digitalisation, sustainability, technological innovation, resilience in farming, as well as the main challenges and opportunities faced by the agricultural sector today.

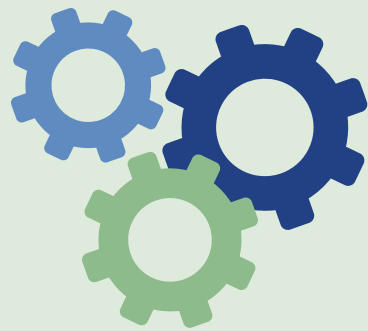
The project has also gathered valuable insights from farmers, vocational education and training providers, academics, policymakers, and trade union representatives, ensuring that the results reflect real experiences and actual sector needs. Building on these findings, the project is now gradually moving towards the development of the FARMS 5.0 training programme.
